In terms of **waste management**, Coasters has:

- ◆ Carried out an 'Earth Week' in each municipality on the coast in 2010.
- ◆ In partnership with Natural Resources, a total of four hundred and eighty-seven (487) tree seedlings were distributed to the community of Harrington Harbour and school children attending Mountain Ridge School, St. Paul's School, Cole Mgr Scheffer, and St. Theresa School in 2010.
- ◆ A Beach Clean-up was organized and carried out in La Tabatiere in partnership with the CDLS (Sports & Leisure), youth Centre, and Quebec en Forme Animators in 2010.
- ◆ An Environmental needs assessment study was completed identifying the needs and to assess the programs, services, resources and infrastructures available for environment / waste management and what could be implemented in 2010.
- ◆ A member of the Waste Management Committee for the eastern sector in 2010.
- ◆ Attended a forum in St. Paul's River in 2009 regarding Waste Management on the coast.
