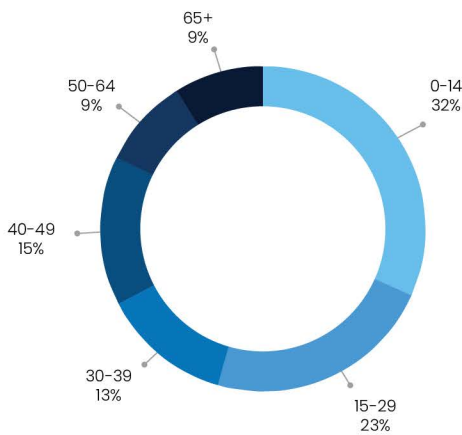


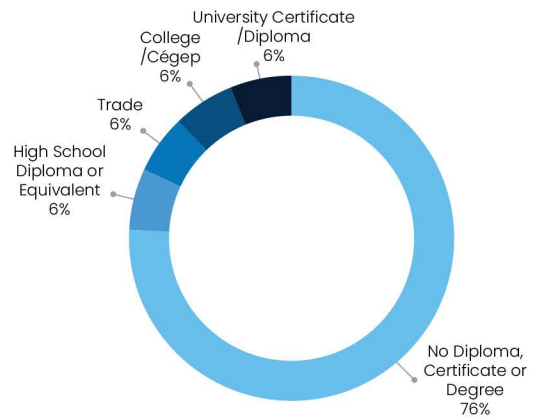
Pakua Shipi:

The easternmost Innu community of the region, Pakua Shipi is located on the west bank of the St. Augustine River. Its name derives from an Innu term meaning “river of sand”. The residents of the community continue to practice traditional Innu activities, such as hunting, fishing, trapping, and handcrafting. They speak the Innu language among themselves and most also speak French.

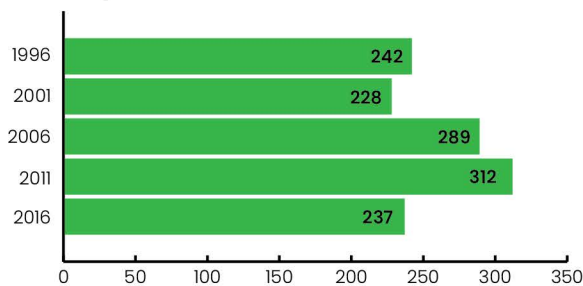
Population Age Groups 2016¹



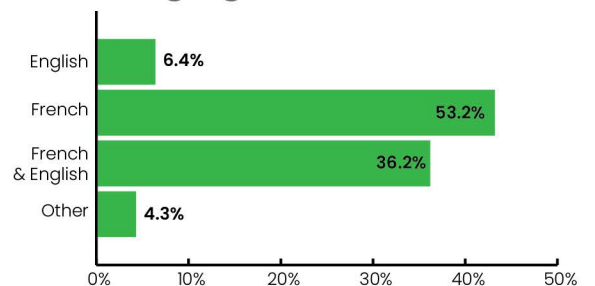
Education Levels 2016¹
