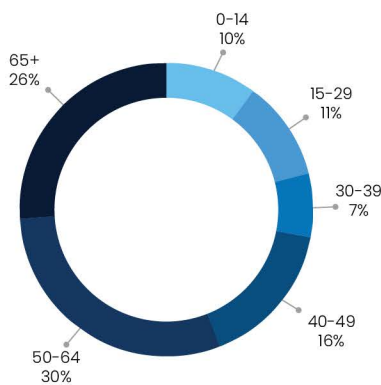


## St. Augustine:

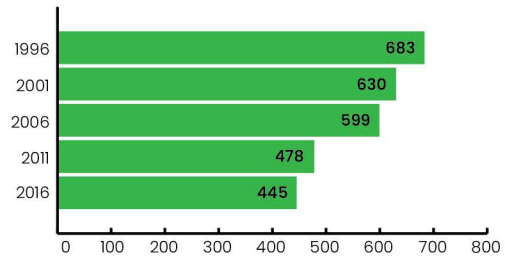
On the east bank of the St. Augustine River is the community of the same name. Early visitors and settlers first stayed on the islands near St. Augustine. Over time, residents moved to the main village in the winter, and then year-round. Some within the community still stay on the islands in the summer to fish multiple different species.



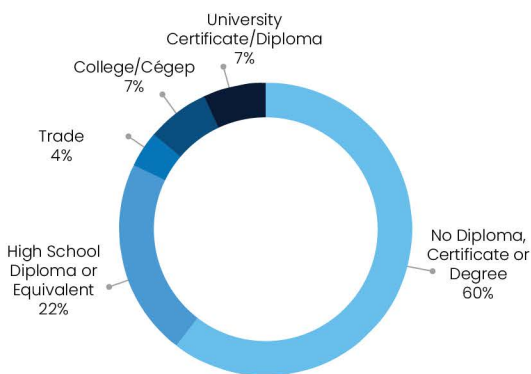
Population Age Groups 2016<sup>1</sup>



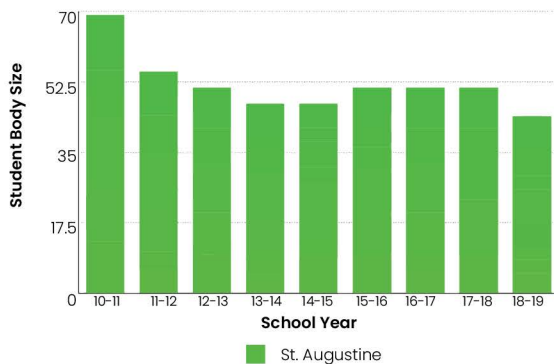
Population Trends 1996-2016<sup>1</sup>



Education Levels 2016<sup>1</sup>

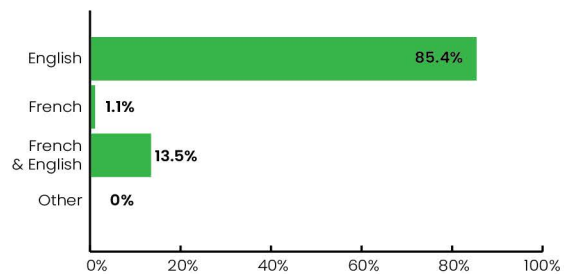


Elementary & Secondary Population<sup>2</sup>
