


Unamen Shipu:


The Innu reserve, Unamen Shipu, dates back to the mid-1950's. Traditionally, they maintained a nomadic lifestyle. Known for their birch bark canoes, the Innu of the Lower North Shore were one of the last nomadic Aboriginal groups in North America. Although they now live a more sedentary lifestyle, the people of Unamen Shipu still carry-on their traditional activities.
